

Terms and Conditions: Friends of Abbotsford Prize Draw – raising funds for the Pavilion Restoration Appeal

These terms and conditions apply to the **Friends of Abbotsford Prize Draw (2021)**

Promoter: The Abbotsford Trust, a registered charity in Scotland. Reg. No. SC037425.

Responsible Person: Tania Murray

Licence: The Friends of Abbotsford Prize Draw is licensed by the Gambling Commission under the 2005 Gambling Act. Licence Number EL651.

Entering the Prize Draw

- Tickets are not to be sold to, sold by, or bought on behalf of, anyone under 18 years of age. Tickets bought by or on behalf of somebody under the age of 18 will be rejected from the draw and the money returned.
- It is open to residents of the United Kingdom (UK) only.
- Participation in this Prize Draw costs £1 per ticket.
- The Abbotsford Trust cannot accept CAF payments for Prize Draw tickets.
- The Abbotsford Trust accepts no responsibility for Prize Draw tickets which are lost, damaged, illegible, or from which the prize-winner cannot be identified. No responsibility is taken for Prize Draw tickets and payment lost, delayed, or damaged in the post and proof of posting will not be accepted as proof of receipt.
- Any Prize Draw ticket monies received after the closing date will be treated as a donation to The Abbotsford Trust and the tickets will not be entered into the draw.
- The Abbotsford Trust cannot claim Gift Aid on Prize Draw ticket monies, but Gift Aid can be claimed on donations.
- The Abbotsford Trust reserves the right to disqualify any entry at their absolute discretion.

The Prize Draw

- The prize winners will be randomly selected in a supervised draw held at Abbotsford on 4th December 2021.
- The first ticket drawn will win the first prize, the second ticket drawn will win the second prize, and this will continue until all the prizes have been won. Winning tickets will be drawn randomly.
- The result of the draw is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- Winners will be notified by post, email, or telephone no later than 2 weeks after the draw date. Winning ticket numbers will be published on our website within 7 days of the draw taking place. The Visitor Centre at Abbotsford will also have a winners' list available. Please keep the ticket as proof of purchase.
- Prizes must be collected from Abbotsford. Alternatively, winners can arrange to pay for postage of their prizes.
- The Abbotsford Trust will endeavour to contact winners. If no contact is made, the unclaimed prize will be treated as The Trust sees fit.
- There are no cash alternatives.

Responsible gambling

- Self-Exclusion: On request we will put a block on supporters' records to exclude themselves from our Prize Draw mailings. This block will remain unless we are asked by the individual to remove it.
